Mtr. Nancy's Ponderings

Dear Brendanites,

Clergy brag on our congregations and I certainly have on St. Brendan's, especially to my former colleagues back in Florida. "I have never seen a congregation who are more concerned with their neighbor, be it next door, in the church or in the world," I tell them. Oh, I cite many examples, but the one that stands out to me the most is "Mask-Up Sunday," which St. Brendan's adopted in the aftermath of the pandemic. This is the first Sunday of the month in which we show our love and care to those whose health is more vulnerable. These folk stream our 10 o'clock service every Sunday, but Mask-Up Sunday has made it possible for them to join us in person.

Recently, two of our parishioners, who have been able to attend the service due to their fellow members' willingness to mask up, approached the vestry to recommend easing the mask-up restrictions. Instead, they proposed that masks be optional for all services and worn only if someone has a cold or is not feeling well that particular day. Their point is that most businesses are not masking up these days, although they still do. The vestry, after deep consideration, agreed.

Moving forward, those attending the 10 a.m. Sunday service will be asked to please be considerate and wear a mask when recovering from a respiratory illness or if they are not feeling well. Masks will continually be made available in the church to all who need them. By being aware of how you are feeling and acting accordingly (mask or no mask), we can continue to love and care for those whose health is vulnerable.

If you've already taken a backpack from the parish hall before the list was available, please contact Annie with the number of the backpack you're filling.


Next week the backpacks will be delivered to children in need.
