The monthly Children's Service is THIS Sunday October 30. Children and youth are invited to wear a Halloween or saint costume to church and process in a "Saints Parade" during the opening hymn, accompanying the choir with shakers, drums, and other instruments. While the lives of the saints were often gruesome, we ask that costumes not include weapons or other violent imagery.

There is now **Children's Table** in the parish hall during Hospitality Hour. The Children's Table will be a safe place for children to complete fun activities while their parents are free to socialize with other adults. Many activities will be service oriented like making special cards for others, decorating food bags for Miryam's, and making food bank flyers. The table will be supervised by volunteers from the Youth group.

We are **seeking a coordinator of children and youth programs**, pre-K through Grade 12.

The applicant for this position should have a strong commitment to the religious education of all children. He or she should be familiar with curriculum used in Sunday School and with teen programs in Episcopal churches. Applicants should be able to demonstrate strong communication skills with children, youth, and parishioners and should be able to work as part of a team to deliver sound instruction and experiences.

This is a paid, part-time position and requires attendance on Sundays for Sunday School, designated evenings for teen programming, and other meetings and events as they may arise.

We are also seeking a paid part-time **Nursery Director** who is present in the nursery during the 10 a.m. Sunday service to supervise and safeguard the children of adult worshipers and who recruits volunteers to ensure two-person coverage during formal nursery hours. The director must display enthusiasm for the ministry, cheerfulness in dealing with children, and skill in working with other adults in the nursery.

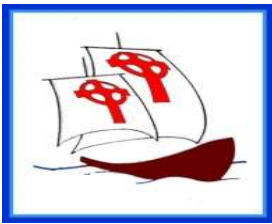
2022 General Election
