

Spiritual Direction Opportunity. I (Ann Vinski) am training to become a spiritual director through Pneuma Institute (https://pneumainstitutesdl.org/sdlp/). As part of the training, I have the opportunity to offer spiritual direction (free of charge!) to individuals who might be interested. Our spiritual direction sessions would focus on your relationship with God. As we talk about your experiences in life, we would explore becoming more aware of God in the everyday events of life, at how God might be calling you to deeper relationship, at what you are experiencing in prayer. It's not counseling (either

pastoral or therapeutic) or coaching. I see spiritual direction as a companionship in which the focus is you and God, and I am there to listen and accompany you on your journey.

Because I am a spiritual-director-in-training, my program provides supervision for my spiritual direction sessions. I would need to record our sessions so that my supervisor can see them and guide me. The recordings will be destroyed after that, if that is your preference.
