The Priest's Corner

OUR LENTEN WORKBOOK and the rest of St. Brendan's 2020 Lenten Adult Formation Offerings, Part 2:

Celebrant: *Repent and believe the Good News.*

All: *Turning from sin, I'll be faithful to God.*

Two years ago we had a Lenten Workbook for those who participated in the Lenten Series on John's Gospel. The feedback was great — people loved the daily Lenten guide. That workbook, we purchased. This year's workbook we are creating ourselves, so it will be more customized and coincide with some Lenten practices our children will be doing — and the Lenten Workbook this year will be available to every Brendanite, at no cost. It will give you room for daily journaling and reflection. It will have different prayers to pray all 46 days of the Lenten season. It will suggest unique Lenten actions to take every day during Lent. In addition, it will provide you space to take notes and capture insights when you participate in the Sunday prayer series and Wednesday evening Meager Meal and *It's a Beautiful Day in the Neighborhood* Lenten series. It's meant for you to have with you, or nearby, throughout Lent. Keep it on your nightstand, check the daily prayer and Lenten practice when you wake up in the morning. Spend one minute before you go to sleep at night, answering a few questions about your day or recording a memorable moment from that day. You'll want to take it to church, write a note on an insight you receive during a hymn or at liturgy, record insights from the Prayer workshop and when you see the movie, *It's a Beautiful Day in the Neighborhood* on Ash Wednesday.

Last week we discussed our Sunday Lenten Series which is based on Gary Neal Hansen's book on prayer called *Kneeling with Giants*. We have six sessions of various prayer forms scheduled for the Sundays during Lent. You'll have a chance to practice the new prayer form each week as well. I learned an interesting tidbit since last week regarding the author, Gary Neal Hansen. He's from Canada, living currently in Pittsburgh and attending our Episcopal church in Squirrel Hill. I have contacted him, and we are trying to arrange for him to visit us during our Lenten series. Stay tuned. If you'd like to purchase a copy of his book, contact Katie.

She will be able to give you the information you need to get it. (You will not need a copy of the book to participate in the program.) I was able to get five previously-owned copies for around \$10.00 each.

Now let's examine the Wednesday evening Lenten series, beginning with a Meager Meal at 5:30 PM on Ash Wednesday and the full movie, *It's a Beautiful Day in the Neighborhood*. As time permits, we will briefly discuss it. We will be finished at 6:55, affording those wishing to attend liturgy and get ashes to do so at 7:00.

Our sessions will utilize a portion of our Lenten Workbook and they will be largely discussion, some scripture and prayer, some one-on-one conversations and a bit of content. You'll have time to journal and capture insights. Here are the topics we will discuss:

- February 26--Ash Wednesday—Overview to the series and view the movie, *It's a Beautiful Day in the Neighborhood*.
- March 4--Feelings
- March 11--Prodigal
- March 18--Anything Mentionable/Manageable
- March 25--Forgiveness and Reconciliation
- April 1--Practice, Practice--End of Program
- April 8--HOLY WEEK--Reflect on your own

I am hoping for at least six participants. The only investment that you need to make is attendance: it's suggested you participate in at least half the sessions, with a commitment to do the work of the sessions you miss. The other commitment is that you supply enough food to feed the six participants for a total of \$20.00 or less. You supply food only one time. The purpose of a \$20 limit to feed six is that we get to be creative and to budget, as many of our brothers and sisters in the world have to stretch to feed their loved ones. As such, it's an experiential part of the series to grow our empathy connectivity. It's our hope that we will all learn and gain something important through this practice. Now, say we have 12 people attending: for every six people we will add another volunteer to help supply the Meager Meal. There will be sign up lists for this. I'll take the first slot on Ash Wednesday.

This is adding up to a Lent with plenty of opportunities individually and as a community to find a deeper connection with the Lord. Mark your calendars, make a special, intentional effort to stretch and make this Lent one that is memorable for you and those you love. Please look for and get your 2020 St. Brendan's Daily Lenten Workbook.


The next CRIES meeting is **Sunday, March 15**. All are welcome.






