Supper Club

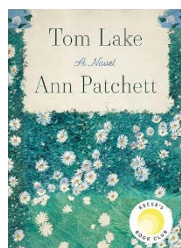
2025 Supper Club will be meeting 3 times next year. The sign-up sheet will be in the narthex through December, please sign up. We will start in January.

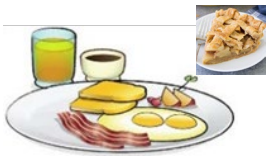

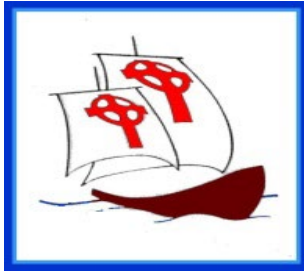

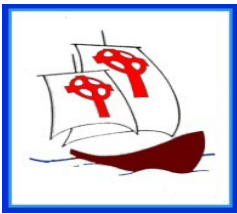
