From the Senior Warden

Dear Brendanites,

I can remember learning as a child about the fundamental teachings of Jesus. You probably heard the same, whether it came from a priest or parent or Sunday School teacher: Jesus calls us to feed the hungry, shelter the homeless, welcome the stranger. Never did we think that, years later, something so fundamentally humane would be contrary to policies imposed by some of our elected leaders. Yet here we are.

While the shocks and outrages in the news come at us almost daily, St. Brendan's remains steadfast in following the ways of Christ and providing anyone with opportunities to live their faith. Collecting clothing for those who are without. Teaching English to immigrants. Providing food for mentally challenged women. Filling backpacks with school supplies for needy kids. Giving 10 percent of parish income to groups that help our most vulnerable sisters and brothers.

It was in this same spirit that St. Brendan's Vestry recently adopted a protocol, developed by diocesan lawyers, for how a parish might respond if immigration agents suddenly appeared at church to seek records or seize people. While such an episode at St. Brendan's is highly unlikely, the vestry is determined to protect the rights of both our church and our visitors. The protocol is not obstructionist, but it seeks to ensure that proper legal procedures are followed. (Send me an email If you'd like to see a copy.) Our first step, should such a visit occur, would be to contact one of the diocesan attorneys, who will then take charge of the scene.

Two weeks ago, St. Brendan's clergy, staff, security stewards and ushers gathered for a Zoom meeting to review and discuss the protocol. The idea, at a minimum, was to make sure we were all on the same page. Those who couldn't attend were urged to examine the same materials. As a followup, I contacted the diocese to ask a few clarifying questions and also to recommend that a diocesan-sponsored training session be provided to relevant ministry leaders of all parishes.

The reason I am sharing this is not to be alarmist, but to assure you that Mother Nancy, the vestry and I take St. Brendan's security seriously and Jesus' call to welcome the stranger to heart. We may not, for now, be able to stop the cruel treatment of immigrants that is taking place around our country, but we can at least demand that they be treated fairly, humanely and within the rule of law.
